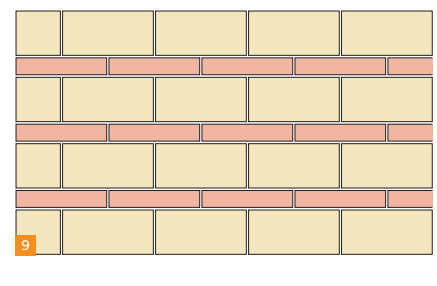
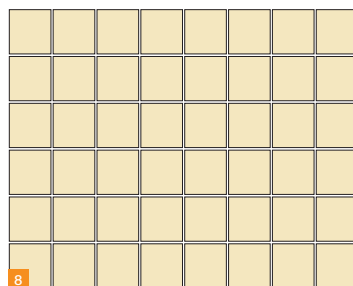
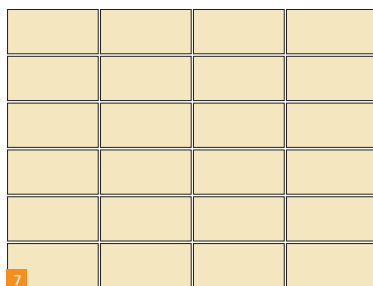
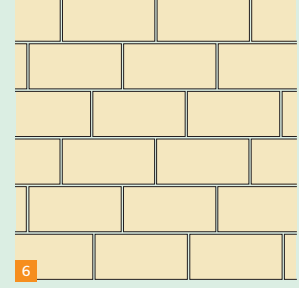
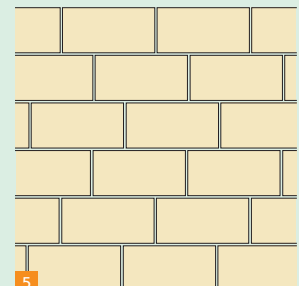
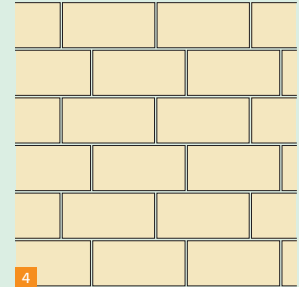
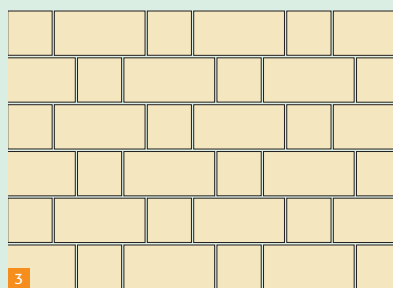
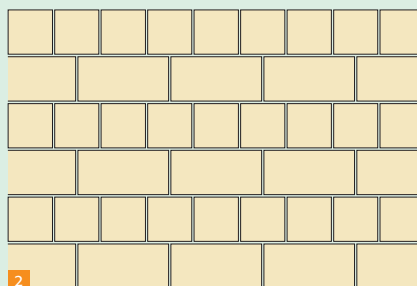
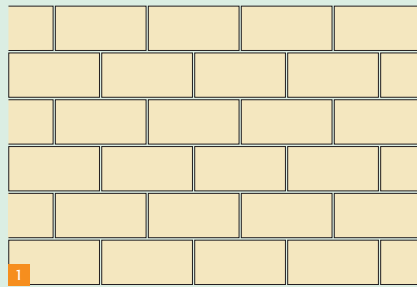


PATTERNS IN BONDING



MORTARS

To achieve the most pleasing appearance all colours in the Plasmor Architectural Masonry range should be used in conjunction with complementary coloured mortar. Refer to the mortar manufacturers for shade guides and mortar samples before ordering bulk materials.



1 Running Bond

Half-block lap. Has good strength properties.

2 English Bond

Alternate courses of half/whole blocks.

3 Flemish Bond

Alternate blocks half/whole.

Running Bond

Third or quarter block lap. Large scale variations in pattern may be made by varying perpend alignment.

4 Zipper,

5 Chevron

6 Diagonal.

7 Horizontal Stack Bond

Visually attractive and easy to lay out, needs reinforcement to compensate for the lack of interlock.

8 Vertiblock Stack Bond

9 Coursed Ashlar

Provides an interesting effect using alternative courses of full blocks and blocks cut to required height.
