

# Transparency in Supply Chain policy

## Health and Safety policy statement

As a business we recognise and accept our responsibilities to safeguard, as far as is reasonably practicable, the health, safety and welfare of our employees and those who may be affected by our operations. - management teams pro-actively managing health and safety as part of their day-to-day activities,
- all employees being held accountable for their own personal duties and responsibilities for health and safety at work,
- the control of visitors and contractors whilst on the Company premises,
- the provision of adequate welfare facilities

The Company Health and Safety Policy Manual provides further details in respect of how health and safety is managed within the business and is updated as necessary.

The Board, as the directing mind of the business, expects all employees to personally contribute to maintaining the health, safety and welfare of themselves, their colleagues and other persons who may be affected by our business undertakings.
