

Health and Safety Policy Statement

This is the Health and Safety Policy Statement of the Plasmor Group of Companies.

It is the intention of the company to take due care of its employees, customers, visitors and others who may be affected by its activities, and comply with all legal requirements applicable to occupational health and safety so far as is reasonably practicable.

This policy will be implemented through the Health and Safety Manual of which it forms the first part.

The manual sets out the ways in which the company will pay due attention to its obligations under the law. The company intend to achieve compliance with statutory standards as a minimum, with the aim of achieving best practice where possible.

The company recognises that it has responsibilities for:

-  The provision and maintenance of safe and healthy plant, equipment and systems of work.
-  The safe handling, storage and transport of materials and products.
-  The provision of information, instruction, training and supervision.
-  The maintenance of a safe and healthy workplace and access to and from it.
-  The provision of a safe and healthy working environment, adequate welfare facilities, and appropriate health surveillance.

The company is committed to continual improvement, and objectives will be established at site level and board level.

All employees are reminded of their personal duties for their health and safety, and the need to co-operate with the company. Health and safety are regarded as an integral part of every person's duties. An appropriate level of resources and specialist support will be maintained to enable individuals to discharge their duties properly.

The management procedures are based upon risk assessments, which are separately documented.

This Policy, and the manual will be reviewed on a regular basis, and when significant changes are made to the organisation, legislation or standards, or the assessments of risk alter.
